Tip One:

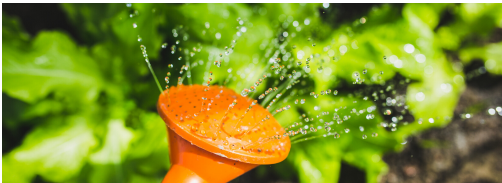
Deadhead your perennial flowers!



Tip Two:

Harvest your garden daily, it is prime time for vegetables and fruit!

To protect your garden from unwanted pests we suggest adding netting on top of your plants!

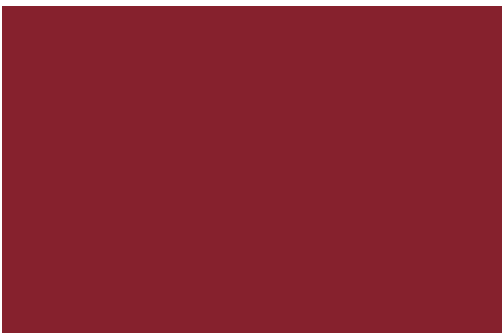


Tip Three:

Pot up your succulents and cacti! This is perfect for some cacti to freshen up your yard and decorate. They are extremely low maintenance and prefer to just be left alone and watered VERY occasionally.

Tip Four:

Tip Five:

Freshen up your mulch. Mulch increases soil moisture, reduces weed competition, and improves the quality of your garden.

Tip Six:

Freshen up your flower beds and containers with heat-loving annuals like zinnia, lantana, and pentas.

Tip Seven:

Invest in some shade loving plants. Hostas come in a diverse set of colors, sizes, and shapes while looking lovely almost anywhere. Other beautiful shade plants are caladium, coleus, and heuchera.

Tip Eight:

Deadhead your flowers. Removing old blooms will leave room for new growth to spurt as well as prevent plants from setting seed. Also, pruning back your salvia, petunias, etc will leave room for new growth that is fuller and vibrant to begin.

Tip Nine:

Take care of the birds by providing pools, ponds, and baths for them to cool off and hydrate in! During these dry spells water is hard to come by and our feathered friends will appreciate it.

Tip Ten:

Summer heat is picking up. It is best to watch your plants closely for wilting. Water your garden in the evening or later in the day to conserve water being lost from evaporation.

Tip Eleven:

Prune your trees. This is the perfect time to prune your trees and reshape them.
